Open Session

Board Business:

Phone system upgrade

Ms. Leonard is looking into a new phone system. One proposal has been received. There would be new hardware without a charge. This company is highly recommended from other libraries. The monthly bill would be less than the current bill.

Construction/ Building Updates:

Bathroom renovation update

The final bid package has not been received.

Exterior Front Door Saddle Replacement

Exterior front door saddle will be replaced. A date has not yet been scheduled.

Water Treatment Proposal

Treating the boiler will help with the maintenance of the pump. A test revealed that there is hard water. The cost for annual treatment would be \$760 and would include three treatments per year.

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Painting projects

We are in the process of getting quotes. The last time the library was painted was 10 years ago. Some walls need spackling and there are areas that had leaks that would need repair as well as wood window trim that needs attention. Two companies did walk-thoughs and we are expecting one more. Once estimates have been received, they will be given to the Buildings and Grounds Committee.

Hvac

Pump 5 needs to be rebuilt. This project would be about \$3000. There is money in the budget for repairs such as this.

AV upgrades

Ms. Leonard is starting to get proposals. This may be a multiple phase project that would start this year and continue next year. The screen in the Shotmeyer Room needs replacement as soon as possible due to leaking oil, stickiness on the screen and occasional jamming. Microphones need upgrading per FCC. The touch panels need to be replaced. The gradual replacement of this AV system is necessary if groups will be using the meeting rooms.

Donation Update

The books purchased with the Bennett donation have mostly been received. The Frenkel donation is paying for a program that has been moved to April in addition to books that will be purchased.

Girl Scout Silver Award Proposal

Three Girl Scouts are proposing to create an outdoor art installment consisting of three freestanding shapes reusing plastic bottle caps. This outdoor art creation would go near the labyrinth and a larger mural would be placed just past the labyrinth. They have all the bottle caps because they have been collected, cleaned and separated by size. They have experience creating art with bottle caps from school projects.

BCCLS Vega app and discovery ayer

The 2022 BCCLS budget includes funding for a mobile app and discovery layer. This app will allow for many additional features beyond the website. The discovery layer enhances the user experience through better search functionality as well as many features for reader advisory. The app can be customized for each member library. It should be available early 2022. BCCLS received favorable pricing as an early adopter.

There have been multiple community groups that have made use of the meeting rooms. Patrons have been in compliance with the mask mandate. Ms. Leonard recommends that we continue the course we are on regarding the mask mandate and possibly add more furniture. This will be revisited next month.
